



DOQS Maintenance Contract

(Licensed and Insured Service Contractor)

This contract for equipment maintenance services between _____ (hereafter referred to as Client) and Dekk't Out Quilting Supply, (hereafter referred to as Contractor) is made and entered into on (date) _____ **MM/DD/YYYY**.

Client owns or has legal control of long arm quilting machine, frame and equipment, specified and described in the List of Equipment attached and hereby incorporated into this contract by reference.

Client desires that the long arm quilting machine & frame equipment be maintained in good working order. Such maintenance service is to include annual home visit for machine & frame cleaning, maintenance, and inspection of all parts.

The Client will also have unlimited access by phone, fax or e-mail with the Contractor to discuss any problems relating to the service, maintenance, or repair of their long arm quilting machine, frame and equipment.

Contractor is licensed, certified and insured to be in the business of providing equipment maintenance services, and hereby undertakes to provide the following maintenance services to Client:

1. All of the Equipment listed shall be inspected and serviced on an annual basis, as prescribed in the owner's maintenance manual published by the manufacturer of each piece of Equipment.
2. Contractor shall ensure that all services provided under the terms of this contract are performed by persons trained and certified as proficient in the provision of the services provided by an accredited school or manufacturer's training program.
3. Contractor represents and warrants that all personnel provided by Contractor to do work on Client's equipment are legally eligible to work in the United States of America; and that Contractor complies with all applicable federal and state wage and employment laws, and with all other applicable laws and regulations pertaining to the services provided to Client. Evidence of Liability Insurance is available upon request.

In consideration of services provided by Contractor, the Client agrees as follows:

1. To pay to Contractor the annual sum of \$300 for the duration of this contract, this amount is due at the inception of the contract.
2. To pay to Contractor additional repair costs performed by Contractor for said repair in the event a repair or parts replacement would be necessary to fix the machine/frame and equipment.
3. To purchase from Contractor such parts, supplies, and other materials as may be necessary and reasonable in order to maintain the Equipment in good working order. It is understood that the success and satisfactory performance of any maintenance service or repair performed by Contractor depends upon the quality of materials used.


Therefore, Client shall be fully responsible for any failure or dissatisfaction arising from any service or repair that is done using materials not purchased from or specified by Contractor.

Invoices for repair fees, itemizing all goods and services billed, shall be submitted by Contractor to Client upon completion of repair. Client shall pay each invoice when presented.

This contract shall expire on the anniversary date of this contract, at which time the parties may extend it by agreement in writing.

Any dispute or cause of legal action that may arise from either party's performance under this Contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of _____ and applicable federal law. Any litigation arising from this Contract shall be filed and tried in the Contractor's local jurisdiction.
